
Every Julie Billiart Schools student is unique with their own set of special needs. Generally, JB students meet the following criteria:



Has an Ohio Evaluation Team Report (ETR) and Individualized Education Program (IEP) OR

Autism Education Plan (AEP) and Autism Diagnosis

Mild-to-Moderate Learning and Social Differences including but not limited to:



- Dyslexia/Dysgraphia/Dyscalculia
- Mild-to-Moderate Autism
- Anxiety
- Language Delays
- Executive Functioning Deficits



Age Requirements

- Begindergarten 5 Years Old by September 30
- Kindergarten 5 Years Old by August 1



Once you complete your application, we will follow up to go over your materials, learn more about the child and answer any questions!

Screening Activity



The screening activity is a required part of the application process and will be scheduled during your Application Review Call. Screenings take place monthly at designated campuses.



Screenings are set up as a mini school day, administered by the Screen Team and include social and academic activities (reading, math, writing and recess).

The Screen Team is comprised of our principals, intervention specialists, occupational therapists, speech-language pathologists, behavior support and admissions team.

What sets JB apart is the principal, assistant principal, teachers and support staff and how they are committed to hanging in there with you. They partner with you as the parent and your child to figure out how to climb that mountain. Not only that, they put on their gear and climb it with you.

Admission Decision



Once the screening activity is completed, the Screen Team will meet to evaluate Julie Billiart Schools' ability to serve the child. Because we have rolling admissions, we do our best to follow up within a week of the screening activity.

Please note, if you are interested in Julie Billiart Schools again in the future, re-screening can take place one calendar year following initial screening activity date.

Julie Billiart Schools keeps tuition and fees as low as possible to make our education feasible for all families.

2025-26 Tuition: \$36,100

Tuition includes our award-winning educational curriculum, in-house therapies such as speech, occupational, music and art. An additional \$100 academic fee covers the cost of supplies and technology for each student. Tuition does NOT include: uniforms, transportation, lunch and Aftercare.

JB students are eligible for either the Jon Peterson Special Needs Scholarship or the Autism Scholarship. Families can apply for the scholarship after being accepted to Julie Billiart Schools.

The chart below shows maximum scholarship amounts based on the child's special education category as designated by their ETR. The family is responsible for costs exceeding the scholarship in addition to services not identified in the IEP. Julie Billiart Schools offers need-based financial aid on a first-come basis.

Through generous gifts from individuals and community partners, Julie Billiart Schools offers over \$1 million in need-based financial aid per year.

All JB families may receive financial support in the form of scholarships from the Ohio Department of Education and financial aid.

Each family is
expected to pay
some out-of-pocket
tuition costs;
approximately
6-10% of their annual
household income.

JB offers payment plans that work for your family! We'll partner with you to create a plan that works best for your needs.

Once you receive your enrollment offer, you may begin the scholarship and financial aid application process.

Our admissions team will provide separate online scholarship and financial aid applications and guide you through the process.

Once your package is awarded, you will receive the Family Responsibility Agreement which will include scholarship amounts, financial aid and family responsibility.

If you enroll after the start of the current school year, tuition and scholarships are prorated.

The admissions team will continue to work with you throughout the process including scheduling orientation, determining start date, and other onboarding activities.
