Update Regarding Faculty & Staff Vaccination Timeline

Dear JB Families,

As the COVID-19 Vaccination becomes available in Ohio, Julie Billiard Schools are working closely with our local boards of health to secure the vaccine for our school employees. We've strongly encouraged all of our faculty and staff to get the vaccine in order to protect themselves and their students from the ongoing spread of COVID-19.

According to Gov. DeWine's tiered system, beginning in early February, **employees*** of K-12 schools that wish to remain or return to in-person or hybrid models will become eligible. We do not yet know the exact date of when the vaccine will be available for our school employees. Our local boards of health have shared that we will have a limited period of time and limited locations to allow our faculty and staff to receive the vaccine. For this reason, we are asking our families to remain flexible as February approaches.

Depending on the window we are given, we may need to operate on an early dismissal one day or cancel school one day to allow our faculty and staff time to get the vaccine.

As always, we will keep our families informed as soon as we are made aware of next steps, dates, and times. We are so grateful for your health and continued support. As always, if you have any questions or concerns, please reach out.
