COVID Updates, Julie Billiard Schools

Dear JB Families, Faculty, and Staff,

Over the past few weeks, we've seen a number of COVID-19 cases in our schools. While some of this is to be expected, we also know that we can all do a better job as a community to slow the spread and keep our schools open. As cold and flu season approaches, it's even more important to be vigilant about illness and mindful of when you're sending your child to school. Please note the following and help us keep our kids and classrooms healthy.

- Do not send your child to school if he or she is experiencing [COVID-19 symptoms](#).
- Do not send your child to school if there is a confirmed case of COVID-19 in your household. If there is a case in your household, we require that you keep your child home for 10 days and recommend that you get him or her tested.

“Quarantine if you have been in close contact (within 6 feet of someone for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period) with someone who has COVID-19, unless you have been fully vaccinated. People who are fully vaccinated do NOT need to quarantine after contact with someone who had COVID-19 unless they have symptoms. However, fully vaccinated people should get tested 3-5 days after their exposure, even if they don't have symptoms and wear a mask indoors in public for 14 days following exposure or until their test result is negative.” [Read more](#) about quarantine guidelines from the CDC.
- Do not send your child to school if your child OR someone in your household is awaiting test results for COVID-19.
- You must notify your school immediately if you are considered a close contact or someone in your household has tested positive for COVID-19. We're required to report these numbers to the state.
- Julie Billiard Schools will continue to require masks for all students, faculty, and staff until otherwise notified. Our COVID-19 Response Team meets weekly to discuss and evaluate.
- As a reminder, students who are called to quarantine due to being named close contacts will receive two weeks worth of take home work. We are not offering a virtual learning environment this year.

Please remember that community spread has great potential to put our students, faculty, and staff at risk. We appreciate your support. As always, if you have any questions or concerns, please reach out.
