Thank you for your continued support of our COVID-19 Policies and Protocols. Because we have maintained social distance, thoroughly cleaned surfaces, and wore masks, we saw relatively few cases in our schools this month.

Though we certainly understand the varied opinions on the subject, having our kids in masks has allowed us to remain open and not send entire classes or grades to quarantine when cases do arise. Per [Ohio's Guidelines](#), the current mask policy is allowing our students to come to school, stay in school, see their friends, and learn.
