Expectations for our Parents or Guardians

Please read these expectations carefully as our ability to serve our students' needs require the positive involvement of our parents and guardians.

We will:

- Treat your child with respect and kindness.

- Be guided by our philosophy of high expectations for our students.

- Listen and attempt to problem solve with you.

- Recognition that the education of your child is a joint responsibility of the parents and the JB Schools' community.

- Your help in building a strong rapport with teachers, other parents and other JB Families.
- Respect for all amidst the struggles and sensitive matters of our community.
- You will trust the faculty and staff to partner with you on your child's journey.
- Prompt notice of changes at home that may affect student conduct or performance.
- Understanding that students will succeed when home/school are on the same page.
- Timely attention to your financial commitment to the school, we provide exceptional service- we rely on you to agree and promptly pay for those services.



Problem Solving:

We know that student success is built upon joint responsibility for communication about, understanding of, and support for JB Schools' expectations and decisions. Should you have concerns or issues regarding your child's journey at JB Schools, please

- Talk to the teacher or administrator that is directly involved and bring up your concerns- we pledge to listen and attempt to problem solve with you
- If your issue is still not resolved, talk with the principal/ other administrators of the school.
- If your issue is still not resolved to your satisfaction, approach the President/CEO to discuss your concerns.

In the problem solving process, we expect you to be respectful to the professionals and:

- to support the decisions made by administration, and
- be supportive of our philosophy of accountability and high expectations for our kids, and our lack of tolerance for difficult behaviors that disrupt the learning environment.
